

**Team:** ISCAN's Complex Needs Nursing Team

**What do we do?** We support young people, their families and / or carers in the following areas:

- Assist in meeting the health needs of children
- Offer support for families and signpost them to other services
- Provide individualised Health Care Plans
- Provide equipment
- Safeguarding and child protection
- For some families we are their lead professional
- Immunisations
- Health screening and nurse led clinics
- Specialised sessions within schools
- Health promotion
- Supporting transition including the writing of passports

We also offer training and support to help develop the skills of those that work with and have contact with the young people.

**Where are we based and where do we work?**

The Children's Complex Needs Nursing team is based at Rowan House in Hyde, but work in a variety of different settings e.g. Mainstream schools, community clinics, special schools, the young person's home and nurseries.

**Who do we work with?**

Young people aged 0-19 in Tameside and Glossop, their families and / or carers.
